
Old Business

Buyer cannot get financing without the road being "a road". Justin made a motion and Grayling seconded for the township to write a letter that Von Road on the east side of the freeway has not been abandoned and is a no maintenance road. George abstained from vote.
- Discussion of the hospital board with Bob Springer, updated the township on the free training for first responder. Also wanted input on the newsletters that the board prints.
- Discussion of hospital board pay. Justin made a motion and Grayling seconded to pay back to 2019 the missed hospital board stipend. All agreed. *all roads*
- Hunter Road not being graded. Justin made a motion to grade ~~Hunter Road~~ *all roads* everytime, Grayling seconded. All agreed.
- Betty to bring bills for cost sharing of roads with other townships to get it all separated out.
- FEMA – need to get pictures of the washed out culvert on Two rivers road, also invoices from Ron Rabe and Trent Rabe. Also need a contractor policy – Justin made a motion and George seconded that the board discusses needs at a regular board meeting and with a motion hires contractors. All agreed.
- LIRP funding – Grayling to look at.
- Just made a motion and Grayling seconded to give the county back the election money that was granted (\$56). All agreed.
